

2021-2022 Student Uniform Policy

The student Dress Code is designed to promote student health, school safety, conditions conducive to learning, and standards of modesty, while reducing undue pressure, intimidation, or threats of violence. Pistor Students are scholars who are career and college-bound. We dress for success!

Top Garment: Boys and Girls

Polo Style 2-3 button shirt, collared with sleeves

Solid black, white, red or gray in color

Logo no bigger than 1 inch x 1 inch allowed

No oversized shirts

Only solid black, white, red or gray t-shirt may be worn beneath polo shirt

Pistor T-shirts may be worn instead of polo (must be purchased through AVID club)

Boys Bottom Garment:

Solid khaki, tan, or black colored pants, joggers, sweat pants or walking shorts (not athletic shorts with finished hem or cuff.

Short length must be at the knees

Must fit at the waist- No Sagging

Girl Bottom Garment:

Solid khaki, tan, or black colored pants, joggers, sweat pants or walking shorts (no athletic shorts with finished hem or cuff.)

Skirt or shirt length must be at the knees

No spandex or knit bottoms (leggings/jeggings, yoga pants)

Shoes:

Can be any color

Shoes should have no more than a 1-inch heel

Sandals must cover 75% of foot, this includes Crocs(must use heel strap), no open toes shoes allowed.

No flip-flops/chanclas, slippers, or sliders

Jewelry:

No expensive jewelry should be brought to school

Pierced jewelry may be worn, but be modest in style (no spiked jewelry or large hoops)

Heavy chains, medallions and beads are not allowed

One necklace may be worn under shirt

Outerwear:

Jackets/coats/hats of any color may be worn OUTSIDE

Jackets with a front zip may be any color, printed and have a hood

Pullovers (sweatshirts, hoodies) must be a solid color of red, gray, black and gray, logo no bigger than 1 inch.

Any type of "College" jacket, sweatshirt, or hoodie may be worn to promote a career and college-going atmosphere

Not Allowed:

Hats, hairnets, sunglasses, gloves, scarves (inside the building)

Non-Natural color or novelty contact lenses

Bare midriff

Chains or spikes

Any article of clothing in violation of TUSD dress guidelines (refer to student rights and responsibilities handbook)
