



The Pistor Middle School Student Dress Code is designed to promote student health, school safety, and conditions conducive to learning. Pistor Middle School students are career and college-bound scholars; we dress for success!

Top Garment:

Collared, polo style 2-3 button shirt, short or long sleeved, must cover the abdomen
Solid white, black, gray, or red
Logo no bigger than 1 inch x 1 inch
No oversized shirts
A plain white, gray, or black t-shirt may be worn under the uniform shirt (no red)
Pistor Middle School t-shirts may be worn instead of polo top (these can be purchased through AVID)

Bottom Garment:

Solid khaki, tan, or black pants, joggers, sweatpants or walking shorts (no athletic shorts).
Short or skirt length must be at the knees
Must fit at the waist - no sagging
Cannot be tight/form fitting, no leggings/jeggings
No spandex or athletic material

Pistor Student IDs - Students will be required to wear school IDs. IDs must be visible throughout the school day. IDs will be used to board the school buses.

If lost students will be able to purchase a new school ID for \$3 and lanyard for \$2.

Shoes

Can be any color
Shoes should have no more than a 1-inch heel
Sandals must cover 75% of foot, this includes Crocs (must use heel strap), no open toes shoes allowed.
No flip-flops/chanclas, slippers, or slides

Jewelry

No expensive jewelry should be brought to school (lost or stolen items are the responsibility of the student)
Heavy chains, medallions and beads are not allowed.
Pierced jewelry may be worn, but be modest in style (no spiked jewelry or large hoops)
One necklace may be worn under shirt

Outerwear

Jackets/coats/hats may be worn OUTSIDE during cold or inclement weather
Jackets with a front zip may be any color, printed and have a hood
Pullover (sweatshirts, hoodies) must be solid color of red, gray, black and gray, logo no larger than 1 inch x 1 inch
Any type of "college" jacket, sweatshirt, or hoodie may be worn to promote a career and college-going atmosphere
Hats and hoods must be taken off inside of the classroom

Not allowed

Hats, hairnets, sunglasses, gloves, scarves (inside the building)
Non-natural color or novelty contact lenses
Chains or spikes
Any article of clothing in violation of TUSD dress guidelines (refer to student rights and responsibilities handbook)

Consequences for Uniform Violation
