The Student Dress Code is designed to promote student health, school safety, conditions conducive to learning, while reducing undue pressure, intimidation, and/or threats of violence. Pistor Middle School students are career and college-bound scholars; we dress for success!

Top Garment:

Plain, solid color shirt of red, gray, black, or white Shirts may be collared or rounded crew neck, short or long sleeved Logo no bigger than 1 inch x 1 inch Pistor, AVID, college t-shirts are allowed on Fridays

Bottom Garment:

Plain, solid color pants, jeans, shorts, skirt, sweatpants, or joggers in gray, black, or white (blue jeans are allowed)
No rips or tears
Must fit at the waist - no sagging
No leggings/jeggings, pajama pants, athletic shorts

Shoes

Can be any color Shoes should have no more than a 1-inch heel No flip-flops, slippers, or slides <u>Pistor Student IDs</u> - Students will be required to wear school IDs. IDs must be visible throughout the school day.

IDs will be used to board the school buses. IDs will be used to get breakfast/lunch. IDs will be used to check out items from library.

The first ID is free. Subsequent IDs will cost \$3.00 and charged to the student account, payable by the end of the year.

Jewelry

No expensive jewelry should be brought to school (lost or stolen items are the responsibility of the student)

Outerwear

Jackets with a front zip may be any color and have a hood Pullovers (sweatshirts, hoodies) must be a solid color of red, gray, black and/or white Hats and hoods must be taken off inside of the classroom

Not allowed

Sunglasses (inside the building or classroom)

Bare midriff or exposed underarms

Chains or spikes

Red on red clothing (no more than one article of red clothing at a time)

Any article of clothing in violation of TUSD dress guidelines (refer to student rights and responsibilities handbook)

Consequences for Dress Code Violation

- Students will be given an opportunity to correct attire. If they are unable...
- If student is unable or refuses to correct their attire, parents will be notified and asked to bring the appropriate items of clothing.
- Repeated violations will be subject to disciplinary action (i.e. lunch detention, afterschool detention, etc.)
